

KP Sanghvi Charitable Trust

Late Shri Sanghvi Hajarimalji Poonamchandji Bafna and Late Shri Sanghvi Babulalji Poonamchandji Bafna established KP Sanghvi Charitable Trust on December 12, 1990 in the sacred memory of their parents Late Shri Poonamchandji Dhanaji Bafna and Shrimati Kaniben Poonamchandji Bafna. The Sanghvi Family hails from the generous and kindhearted Oswal community from a small town called Malgaon in Sirohi district of Rajasthan.

Through this Trust, KP Sanghvi encourages and supports the under-privileged sections of society in India by providing disaster relief and contributing towards development at a national level. KP Sanghvi has also contributed to a number of causes, besides providing relief material, rations and medical care where ever it is most needed in the country. KP Sanghvi has taken every step necessary to help those affected by natural calamities or national emergencies.

The Trust also deals with issues in the local communities, at the grassroots level. For instance, In 2001, when Rajasthan (a state in Western India) faced severe droughts for the 3rd consecutive year, the Trust was at the forefront of the relief and aid work towards human beings and animals too.

It took up the important task of providing cattle fodder to the cattle of tribes staying in the interior areas. The Trust dispatched over 400 truckloads of cattle fodder to these tribes to save the cattle - their sole means of their livelihood and income.

The Trust also took up the work of cleaning of ponds and lakes in Sirohi (a city in the South of Rajasthan) which supply regular drinking water to 128 villages across the region.

Over the last 20 years, the Trust has planted around 110000 trees, which today provide shade for pilgrims who visit the holy town of Palitana, besides contributing to the ecological balance to the region.
